## Perks Leading the Polls in Parkdale-High Park

Gord Perks leads the way with 52% of the vote in Ward 4

Toronto, Sept 14<sup>th</sup> – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by The Forum Poll<sup>™</sup> among 160 Ward 4 voters, amongst those decided and leaning, 52% are voting for Gord Perks. Siri Agrell tails behind with 21% of votes.

Dr. Lorne Bozinoff, President of Forum Research says, "Perks maintains a comfortable lead as election day comes closer. Depending on how the next few weeks go, he could possibly see a majority win."

John Tory has a moderate lead, holding 37% of votes. 36% of voters are undecided, while Chloe-Marie Brown holds second place with 13% of votes.

The poll was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 228 randomly selected eligible voters across Parkdale-High Park. The poll was conducted on Sept 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 6%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample and regional results will be less accurate.
