## Almost Two-Thirds Say SNC Will Impact Their Vote

More than half say the situation has worsened their opinion of Trudeau
Toronto, March $1^{\text {st }}$-In a random sampling of public opinion taken by the Forum Poll™ among 1301 Canadians 18 years of age or older, almost two-thirds (TOP2: $59 \%$ ) say the SNC-Lavalin situation will have an impact on their vote, with a third (36\%) saying it will have a strong impact.

More than three quarters (TOP2: 80\%) of Conservative voters say it will impact their vote.

It will likewise affect the vote of one-third (TOP2: 30\%) of Liberals.
About 4 in 10 (BTM2: 41\%) say it won't impact their vote, with a quarter (24\%) saying it won't impact their vote at all.

Almost three-quarters (BTM2: 70\%) of Liberal voters say it won't have an impact on their vote.

## Half say they could confidently explain the situation if asked

Half (TOP2: 55\%) say they could confidently explain the situation related to the Prime Minister's office, with a quarter (27\%) say they could very confidently explain.

Conservatives (TOP2: 62\%) and Liberals (TOP2: 63\%) are most likely to say they could confidently explain the situation.

More than 4 in 10 (BTM2: 45\%) say they couldn't confidently explain the situation, with a quarter (27\%) saying they couldn't do so confidently at all.

Green (56\%), BQ (54\%), or PPC (53\%) voters are most likely to say they couldn't confidently explain it.

## More than half say it's worsened their opinion of Trudeau

The majority (57\%) say that the situation has worsened their opinion of Justin Trudeau, while a third (36\%) said it had no effect, and about 1 in 10 (7\%) said it's improved their opinion of the Prime Minister.

Respondents most likely to say their opinion has worsened include those aged 3544 (64\%), males (64\%), earning \$80-100,000 (62\%) or the most wealthy ( $62 \%$ ), with a college/university (59\%) or post-graduate degree (58\%), living in the prairies (MB/SK) (75\%) or Alberta (76\%), and supporting the BQ (66\%) or PPC (68\%).

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## Methodology

The Forum Poll ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1301 randomly selected Canadians. The poll was conducted February $27^{\text {th }}-28^{\text {th }}, 2019$.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/-3\%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Actual results depend on a Candidate's ability to get their voters out. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
