4-in-10 rate new senators favourably

Enthusiasm highest among youngest

TORONTO April 6th, 2016 - In a random sampling of public opinion taken by the Forum Poll™ among 1455 Canadian voters, close to 4-in-10 rated the seven new senators appointed by Prime Minister Trudeau favourably (38%) and close to a fifth rated them as "excellent" (17%). Enthusiasm for these senatorial choices is highest among the youngest voters (44% favourable, 23% excellent), among the wealthy (\$80K to \$100K - 44%), in Atlantic Canada (44%), among Liberal supporters (58%) as well as among the plurality of New Democrats (41%) and among the best educated (post grad - 45%). In fact, the only group among whom the majority rates these new senators unfavourably are Conservative supporters (52%).

"It appears the Prime Minister has hit the sweet spot with these seven appointments. The last time we tested approval of the senate, barely one in seven were had a favourable opinion (14%), and just a fraction thought the senate was "excellent" (2%)," said Forum Research President, Dr. Lorne Bozinoff.

Methodology

The Forum Poll™ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1455 randomly selected Canadians 18 years of age or older. The poll was conducted on between April 4th and April 5th, 2016.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 3%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Electoral success is dependant on the parties' skill at getting out the vote. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
