## **Saskatchewan Party to form majority**

Toronto, October 25<sup>th</sup> – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by The Forum Poll™ among 1011 Saskatchewan voters, among those decided and leaning over half (56.2%) will vote for the Saskatchewan Party, compared to a little over a third who will vote NDP (35.8%).

The Greens are projected to get 1.7% of the vote, and 1.4% are expected to vote Liberal.

Other parties are expected obtain 4.9% of the vote.

## **Saskatchewan Party to maintain its majority status**

The Saskatchewan Party are projected to form a majority government with 46 of the 61 seats in the legislature, while the NDP will take a distant 15 seats.

“The Saskatchewan Party are expected to make a strong showing on election day,” said Dr. Lorne Bozinoff, President of Forum Research, “and maintain their majority government.”

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### Methodology

The Forum Poll™ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1011 randomly selected British Columbia Voters. The poll was conducted October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 3 percentage points, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at [www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp](http://www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp)

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Actual results depend on a party's ability to get their voters out. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities. 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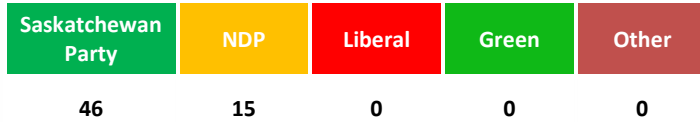


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### **Overall Seat Distribution**



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
