Kandavel Catches up to Crawford in Ward 20

Kandavel and Crawford tied, Berardinetti loses support

Toronto, Oct 19th – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by The Forum Poll™ among 216 voters in Ward 20, amongst those decided and leaning, 28% are voting for Gary Crawford, and 28% for Parthi Kandavel.

Berardinetti's support has dipped from 21% two weeks ago to 6% today.

"Kandavel is making a comeback," says Dr. Lorne Bozinoff, President of Forum Research. "The vote is very divided, we could see this go more than one way."

Tory maintains his comfortable lead with 47% support. Penalosa holds 16% support, while 29% are undecided.

The poll was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 216 randomly selected eligible voters across Scarborough Southwest. The poll was conducted on Oct 18th, 2022. Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 7%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample and regional results will be less accurate.
