Even split in opinion on refugee health care

TORONTO JULY 19th, 2014 – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by the Forum Poll™ among 1624 Canadian voters, there is an even split in opinion between those who believe refugee claimants should receive the same health care as Canadians (44%) and those who do not agree (42%). Agreement with refugees receiving equal care is common to the youngest (48%), the wealthiest (\$100K to \$200K - 49%), those in Atlantic Canada (48%) and the prairies (54\$), but not Alberta (37%). Conservative voters are half as likely to support the idea (25%) as Liberals (52%) and New Democrats (58%).

There is a clear gender gap in these findings, in males and females are relatively equally likely to agree refugees should receive full health care, whereas males are more likely than females to take the opposite positions.

"Canadians cherish their publicly-funded health care, perhaps so much that they are less than happy to share it," said Forum Research President, Dr. Lorne Bozinoff.

Methodology

The Forum Poll™ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1624 randomly selected Canadians 18 years of age and older. The poll was conducted on July 18th, 2014.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 2%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
