Strong opposition to selling Lotto to private sector

Wide majority oppose sale of Lotto to private sector

TORONTO October 1st, 2014 – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by the Forum Poll™ among 1079 Ontario voters, seven-in-ten voters disapprove of OLG's plan to sell the Lotto business to the private sector (70%), and as few as one sixth approve (16%). About one tenth don't have an opinion. (13%). Approval is highest among the youngest (20%), males (22%), mid income groups (\$40K to \$60K - 21%), in Eastern Ontario (29%) and Southwestern Ontario (21%) and among PC voters (24%).

"It's clear Ontarians don't want, by a very wide margin, their government to divest an asset they see as a money maker," said Forum Research President, Dr. Lorne Bozinoff.

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Methodology

The Forum Poll™ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1079 randomly selected Ontarians 18 years of age and older. The poll was conducted on Sept. 30 – Oct. 1st, 2014.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 3%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Actual results will depend on the parties' success at getting their voters out. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
