Even split on Chief Blair's termination

One half say he did good/excellent job

TORONTO August 6th, 2014 – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by the Forum Poll™ among a sample of 1268 Toronto voters, equal proportions approve of the action of the Toronto Police Services Board (TPSB) in not renewing Chief Bill Blair's contract (39%) or disapprove of this decision (41%), while as many as a fifth have no opinion (20%). Those who approve the decision are most likely to be male (46%), those who approve of Rob Ford (56%) and will vote for him (64%), provincial PC voters (57%) and NDP supporters (51%), Those who disapprove are most likely to be younger (48%), provincial Liberal voters (55%) and John Tory supporters (54%).

One half rate Chief "good" or "excellent"

More than one half of Toronto voters (55%) give the chief a positive assessment (excellent - 20%, good - 35%), while just more than a third (37%) give him a less favourable rating (fair - 25%, poor - 12%). One tenth have no opinion (8%). Favourable ratings are common to the oldest (65+ - 64%), females (60%), mid income groups (\$60K to \$80K - 60%), in North York (62%), the least educated (64%), those who disapprove of Rob Ford (63%), provincial Liberals (68%), and John Tory supporters (71%).

"Because of his role in the ongoing Rob Ford controversy, Chief Blair has alienated that portion of the city that supports the mayor. Apart from that, however, he is well-liked and will be missed by the kind of voters who gravitate to John Tory in the mayoral race," said Forum Research President, Dr. Lorne Bozinoff.

Methodology

The Forum Poll™ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1268 randomly selected Torontonians 18 years of age and older. The poll was conducted on August 5-6th, 2014.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate ±3%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
