Majority Approve of Liberal Pharmacare Plan

Toronto, May 12th – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by The Forum Poll™ among 1103 Ontario voters, the majority (56%) approve of the government's plan to offer free prescription drugs to those under the age of 25. A third (32%) disapprove of the plan, with just over 1-in-10 (12%) saying they do not know.

Respondents most likely to say they approve of the plan include those aged 34 and younger (71%), females (60%), earning \$60,000-\$80,000 (63%), living in Toronto (66%), with a post-graduate degree (69%), and supporting the Liberals (72%) or NDP (72%).

Respondents most likely to disapprove of the plan include those aged 55-64 (40%) or 65+ (42%), earning \$40,000-\$60,000 (41%), living in the GTA (33%), Southwestern Ontario (33%), or Northeastern Ontario (34%), the least educated (35%), with some college/university (36%), or a college/university degree (33%), and supporting the PCs (54%).

Methodology

The Forum Poll™ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1103 randomly selected Ontario Voters. The poll was conducted May 9-10, 2017.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 3%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
