O'Brien Fehr Secures Lead in Ward 18

Cheng's support dipped, O'Brien ahead in Willowdale

Toronto, Oct 19th – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by The Forum Poll™ among 205 Ward 18 voters, amongst those decided and leaning, 38% support Markus O'Brien Fehr. 19% support Lily Cheng, and 13% Daniel Lee.

"In the last couple of weeks, O'Brien Fehr has gained support, while his close contender, Cheng, has lost support" says Dr. Lorne Bozinoff, President of Forum Research. "It's still a close race, but things are looking better for O'Brien Fehr."

Tory holds a very strong lead, with 65% of support. Penalosa holds 10% of the vote, while 13% of voters are undecided.

The poll was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 205 randomly selected eligible voters across Willowdale. The poll was conducted on Oct 18th, 2022. Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 7%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample and regional results will be less accurate.
