## **Close to half approve of Ontario Retirement Pension Plan**

## Approval steady since last year

TORONTO March 1<sup>st</sup> - In a random sampling of public opinion taken by the Forum Poll among 1148 Ontario voters, close to half approve of the Ontario Retirement Pension Plan (ORPP), intended for introduction in 2018, as a supplement to the Canada Pension Plan or CPP (44%). In turn, just more than one third disapprove of this supplementary pension plan (37%), and as many as a fifth have no opinion (19%). Approval of the ORPP is especially common to boomers (55 to 64 - 49%), females (46%) rather than males (42%), those in the very highest income bracket (\$100K to \$250K - 50%), in Toronto (52%), among Liberals (65%) and New Democrats (52%) but not PC voters (27%), and among mothers (48%).

This stands in comparison to November, 2015, when an equal percentage (44%) approved of the ORPP as a supplement to the CPP and just fewer disapproved (34%).

"While the ORPP does not garner massive support, it is clearly preferred to no ORPP, and Ontarians recognize the necessity of adding some oomph to their pensions," said Forum Research President, Dr. Lorne Bozinoff.

## Methodology

The Forum Poll<sup>™</sup> was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1148 randomly selected Ontarians 18 years of age and older. The poll was conducted between February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016 and February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

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Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 3%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at <u>www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp</u>

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
