Torontonians Support a \$15.00 Minimum Wage

Toronto, April 6th – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by The Forum Poll™ among 840 Toronto voters, (70%) approve of an increase to the minimum wage in Ontario, from \$11.40 to \$15.00. Only (25%) would disapprove, and (5%) don't know.

Respondents most likely to say that they support raising the minimum wage include those aged 34 and younger (72%), 45-54 (72%), or 65+ (70%), females (75%), earning \$20,000-\$40,000 (84%), the least educated (79%), and supporting the Green Party (89%).

Respondents most likely to oppose an increase to the minimum wage include those aged 35-44 (31%), males (32%), the most wealthy (31%), with a college/university degree (28%) or post-graduate degree (27%), and supporting the Progressive Conservatives (43%)

Methodology

The Forum Poll™ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 840 randomly selected Toronto Voters. The poll was conducted on April 4-5, 2017.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 3%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
