# Two Thirds Approval for the Mayor

### New, lower approvals may be the norm

In a random sampling of public opinion taken by the Forum Poll<sup>™</sup> among 864 Toronto voters, two thirds approve of the way Mayor John Tory is doing his job (67%), and this is identical to last month (July 20 - 67%). However, prior to last month, mayor Tory consistently posted approval ratings in the mid 70s, so recent findings are a decrease.

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The mayor's approval is especially common to the oldest (74%), the wealthy (\$80K to \$100K - 78%), in East York (76%) and among the best educated (post grad - 73%).

"Given that this approval level, though very high, is a departure from approval levels consistently in the mid-seventies since taking office, it may be assumed that the mayor is seeing a more sobereassessment of his work, now that some difficult files have been addressed, than when the only bar he had to clear was not being his predecessor" said Forum Research President, Dr. Lorne Bozinoff.

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## Methodology

The Forum Poll<sup>™</sup> was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 864 randomly selected Toronto adults. The poll was conducted between August 8 and 10, 2016.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 3%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at <u>www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp</u>

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
