### Nicki Ward Makes Comeback in Ward 13

Nicki Ward now slightly ahead of Chris Moise in Toronto Centre

Toronto, Oct 19<sup>th</sup> – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by The Forum Poll™ among 213 Ward 13 voters, amongst those decided and leaning, 39% support Nicki Ward and 27% support Chris Moise.

"Moise was ahead until very recently," says Dr. Lorne Bozinoff, President of Forum Research. "Ward is now leading the polls, but it's still a very close race. We could see this go either way."

John Tory, however, maintains a comfortable lead with 42% of the vote. Penalosa has 19% of support, and 23% of voters are undecided.

The poll was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 213 randomly selected eligible voters across Toronto Centre. The poll was conducted on October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 7%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample and regional results will be less accurate.
