Mulcair should resign – one fifth of NDP supporters

Just one third of Canadians think he should stay

TORONTO April 6th, 2016 - In a random sampling of public opinion taken by the Forum Poll™ among 1455 Canadian voters, one third agree Tom Mulcair should step down as NDP leader (32%), while just more than this disagree (36%). A similar proportion don't know (32%). Agreement Mulcair should resign is common to the youngest (37%), males (35%), the wealthiest (\$100K to \$250K - 40%), equally in Atlantic Canada (41%), the prairies (42%) and Alberta (41%), among Conservatives (40%), parents of Children (37%) and the best educated (post grad - 35%). Of note, just less than a quarter of New Democrats agree he should step down (22%), while just more than half think he shouldn't (56%). About one quarter don't have an opinion (22%). Given that the support figure being discussed for the upcoming leadership review is about 70%, this may prove a problem for Mulcair.

"Just more than half the party supporting your leadership is hardly the ringing endorsement Tom Mulcair needs to win at the convention on April 8," said Forum Research President, Dr. Lorne Bozinoff.

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Methodology

The Forum PollTM was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1455 randomly selected Canadians 18 years of age or older. The poll was conducted on between April 4^{th} and April 5^{th} , 2016.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 3%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Electoral success is dependant on the parties' skill at getting out the vote. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
