Legault approval almost two-thirds

Toronto, September 4th, 2019 – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by The Forum Poll™ among 1219 Québec voters, amongst those decided and leaning, 4 in 10 (43%) say they would support the CAQ, unchanged from July (July 29: 42%).

One-fifth (18%) say they would support the Liberals, down slightly (July 29th: 22%).

One-fifth (18%) say they would support Québec Solidaire, while one-sixth (14%) say they would support the PQ.

1 in 10 (7%) say they would support another party.

If an election were held today, based on this result, the CAQ would secure 87 seats, the PLQ would win 28, QS and PQ would each win 5.

Legault sees high approval

Almost two-thirds (61%) approve of the job Legault is doing as premier, while a quarter (24%) say they disapprove.

1 in 10 (15%) say they don't know.

Legault's net-favourable score (approve-disapprove) is an impressive +37.

Arcand poorly known

More than half (54%) say they don't know whether they approve or disapprove of the job Arcand is doing as opposition leader.

One-fifth (17%) say they approve, while just under a third (29%) say they disapprove.

Arcand's net-favourable score (approve-disapprove) is -12.

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"The summer has been kind to Premier Legault," said Dr. Lorne Bozinoff, President of Forum Research. "He continues to govern from a position of strength and is likely bullish about his agenda for the fall session. If an election were held today, Legault would actually improve his hold on the National Assembly, earning more seats than he did during the election."

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Methodology

The Forum Poll™ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1219 randomly selected Québec voters. The poll was conducted from August 27-28, 2019.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 3%, 19 times out of 20, measured as the average deviation across all response categories. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Actual results depend on parties' abilities to get their voters out. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
