

Half of Quebecers Oppose Transmountain Pipeline

Toronto, July 26th, 2019 – In a random sampling of public opinion taken by The Forum Poll™ among 977 Quebecers, over half (BTM2: 51%) say they do not support the expansion of the Transmountain pipeline, with one third (35%) saying they oppose it strongly.

A third (TOP2: 36%) of Quebecers say they support the expansion of the Transmountain pipeline, with one-fifth (19%) who say they somewhat support it.

Respondents most likely to oppose include those aged 35 to 44 (59%) and 45 to 54 (56%), females (56%), voting QS (80%) in the Québec provincial election, voting for BQ (77%) in the federal election, earning \$100k-\$250k (58%), and who say the environment is the most important issue to them in the upcoming federal election (76%).

Respondents most likely to support include those over the age of 55 (42% of those 55 to 64 and 41% of those 65 and over), males (45%), voting Liberal (47%) in the provincial election, voting Conservative (52%) in the federal election, living in Québec City (52%), and those who said the economy is the most important issue to them in the upcoming federal election (65%).

Methodology

The Forum Poll™ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 977 randomly selected Quebecers. The poll was conducted from July 22-July 24, 2019.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 3%, 19 times out of 20, measured as the average deviation across all response categories. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
