Opposition to Sex Ed Curriculum Down Slightly

Curriculum strongly favoured by moms, wealthiest, best educated

In a random sampling of public opinion taken by the Forum Poll[™] among 1154 Ontario voters, just less than one half approve of the Ontario government's new health education curriculum (47%), while just one third do not approve (33%). One fifth don't take a position on the issue (20%). When we last asked this question in the spring, the proportion opposing the curriculum was slightly higher (June 1, Approve - 48%, disapprove - 36%).

Support for the curriculum is common to females (53%) more so than males (40%), the very wealthiest (\$100K to \$250K - 57%), in the city of Toronto (56%), among Liberals (62%) and New Democrats (59%) but not among Progressive Conservatives (30%), among mothers of children under 18 (59%) and among the best educated (post grad - 55%).

Disapproval of the curriculum is characteristic of boomers (55 to 64 - 40%), the wealthy (\$80K to \$100K - 41%), in the 905 area code surrounding Toronto (36%), among PC voters (49%) and among those with some college (38%).

"It appears the Premier doesn't have much to fear in continuing to support the new curriculum; the voters who most strongly approve are all groups with high turnout, and are capable of making themselves heard over a noisy minority" said Forum Research President, Dr. Lorne Bozinoff.

Methodology

The Forum Poll[™] was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1154 randomly selected Ontario voters. The poll was conducted on September 12 and 13, 2016.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 3%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at <u>www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp</u>

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
