## Methodology

The Forum Poll ${ }^{T M}$ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 210 randomly selected Humber River-Black Creek voters. The poll was conducted on October 19th, 2018.

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.
