Quebec City Continues To Be First Choice For Next Canadian NHL Team

2nd Team in Toronto Not Favoured

TORONTO MAY 26th, 2014 - In a random sampling of public opinion taken by the Forum Poll™ among 1694 Canadians 18 years of age and older, the plurality, or 3-in-10 favour Quebec City as the location for Canada's next NHL franchise (31%), and this proportion has stayed stable since June 2012 (29%). Hamilton, Ontario, is favoured by about half as many (14%), and fewer opt for Saskatoon (10%) or a second Toronto area team (9%). One eight would like to see a franchise somewhere else (16%) and one fifth have no opinion (20%). Enthusiasm for a Quebec City team is highest among Generation Y (35 to 44 - 37%) and, predictably, Quebeckers (77%). A Hamilton team excites interest among Gen X (45 to 54 - 18%) and the oldest (18%) and, of course, in Ontario (26%). Conservative supporters are especially likely to favour a Hamilton franchise (19%), while New Democrats are especially likely to side with Quebec City (39%), as are, of course, Bloquistes (81%).

Methodology

The Forum Poll™ was conducted by Forum Research with the results based on an interactive voice response telephone survey of 1694 randomly selected Canadians 18 years of age and older. The poll was conducted on May 22-23rd, 2014.

Results based on the total sample are considered accurate +/- 2%, 19 times out of 20. Subsample results will be less accurate. Margins of error for subsample (such as age, gender) results are available at www.forumresearch.com/samplestim.asp

Where appropriate, the data has been statistically weighted by age, region, and other variables to ensure that the sample reflects the actual population according to the latest Census data.

This research is not necessarily predictive of future outcomes, but rather, captures opinion at one point in time. Actual results will depend on the parties' success at getting their voters out. Forum Research conducted this poll as a public service and to demonstrate our survey research capabilities.
